Committee 2014 - 2015

Chair of the Forum - Maximo Cirio

As President and Chair of the Latin American Forum 2014, Maximo was responsible to the University for managing the committee and achieving his Forum objectives. Born in Argentina and raised in Uruguay, he moved to the United Kingdom to study at The University of Edinburgh where he specialised in Sustainable Development and Economics.

At Edinburgh, he founded the Sustainable Development Society, and was re-elected President.
